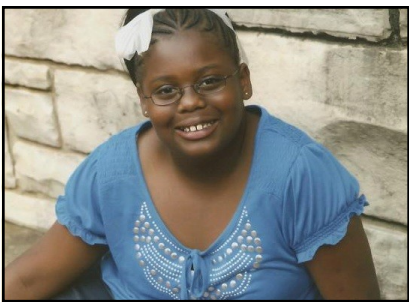

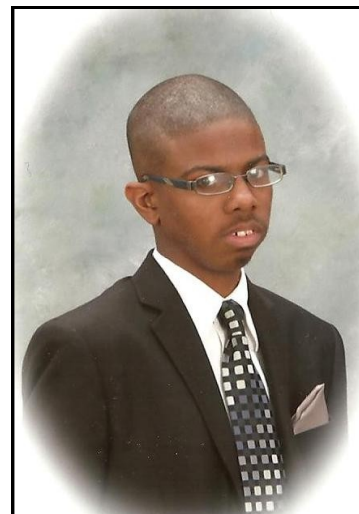
Vivica Parker

High School Graduates

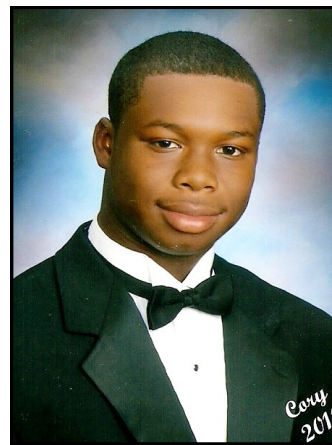

tice. She is the daughter of Venitta Slade.



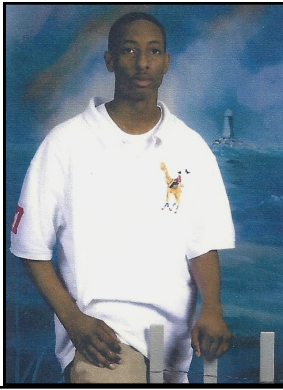
Sampson Gholston, Jr.

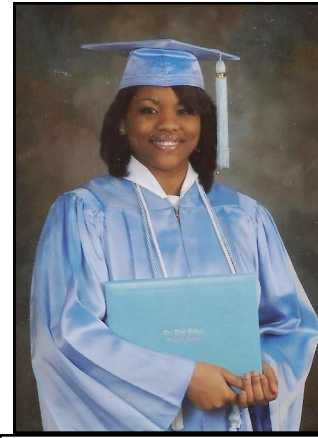
Cory Hale

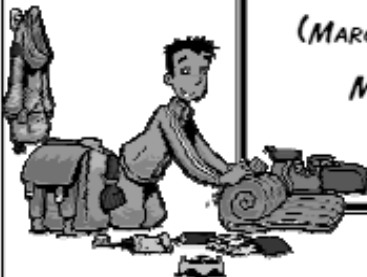

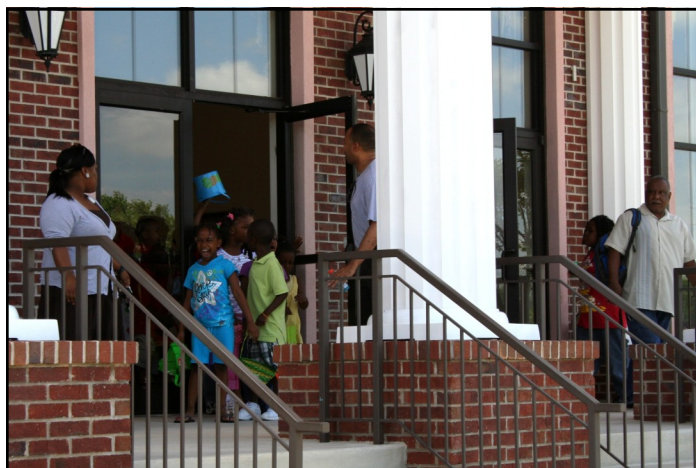
